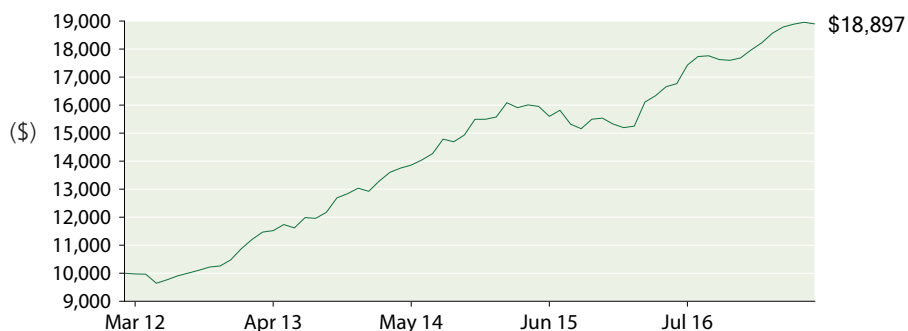

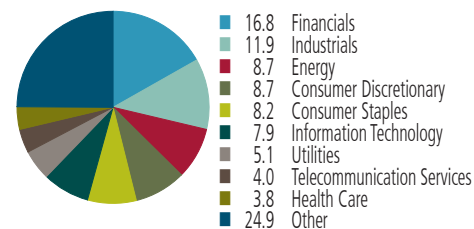

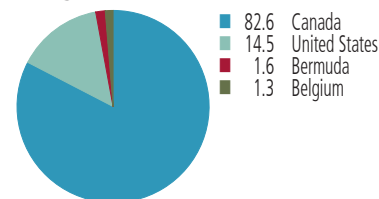

Geographic allocation (%)



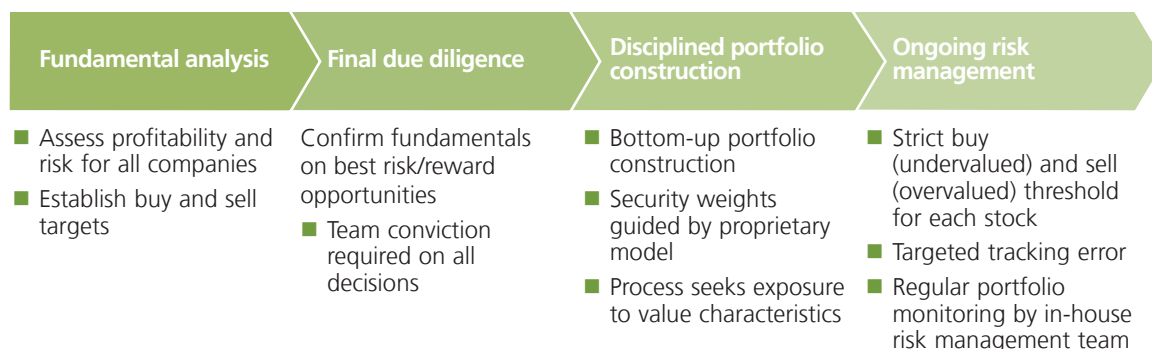
